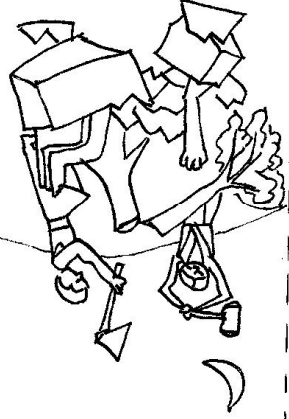
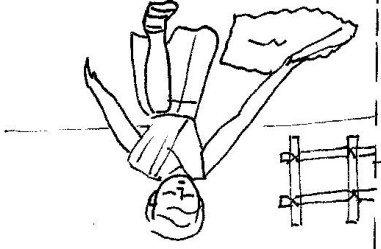
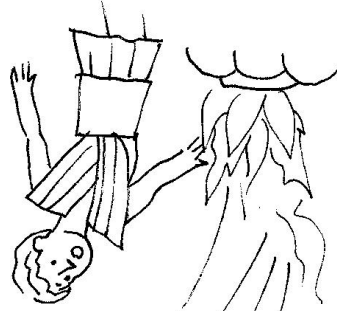


The next morning...

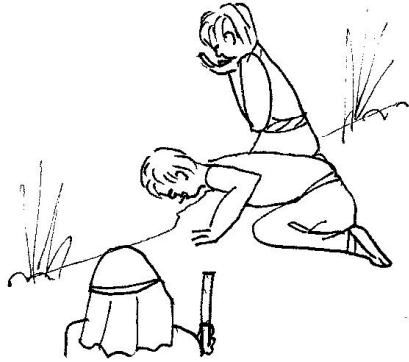
2. Gideon secretly threshes grain

Gideon watches them drink.



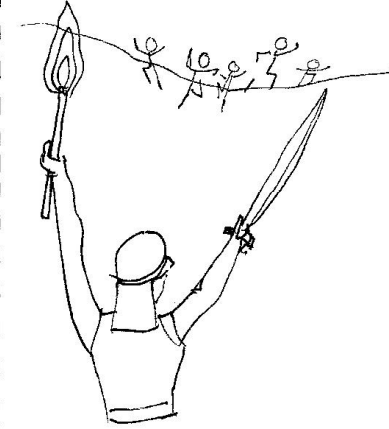
